Description/ Qualifying Criteria: Scholarships awarded to Marshall High School graduating seniors who plan to attend a four-year institution or community college with the intent of completing a four-year degree. Applicants need to demonstrate initiative, positive personal characteristics and a strong work ethic. A minimum 3.0 GPA is required.

Essay Questions: *Please respond to the essay question in a meaningful, but concise essay of 200 words or less.* What do you envision yourself doing in the future to make the world a better place and contribute to society?

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member). **The letter of recommendation should address your leadership qualities, your community involvement and any other pertinent information about you.**

Financial Criteria: Not required
