

PHILLIP R. CLISSOLD VOCAL MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was established within the Marshall Community Foundation in honor of Phillip R. Clissold, retired Marshall Public Schools Music Teacher. Phillip was a highly respected and talented music teacher and had been an inspiration to music students for many years.

The Phillip R. Clissold Vocal Music scholarship provides awards to Marshall Public School choir students (Grade 7-11) wishing to attend a Summer Vocal Music Camp/Seminar. Recipients are required to continue in the vocal music program in good standing for 12 months after being awarded. Western Michigan University or Wolverine Camps are preferred but others will be considered. The amount of the award will vary. Monetary award will be directed to the recipient's chosen enrichment program on the recipient's behalf.

<u>Essay Questions for Enrichment Scholarship:</u> 1) Describe your current, past and anticipated studies in this field. 2) Write a paragraph describing the program in which you wish to participate. Include copies of the printed materials from this program. 3) What do you hope to gain from attending this vocal music camp? 4) Why do you feel you should be awarded this scholarship?

<u>Recommendation Letters:</u> Two required- Please provide one recommendation letter from a Music Teacher with whom you have studied, and one from a Marshall Public School educator/employee.

Financial Criteria: Not required
