The Connelly's will be remembered long into the future as the scholarship bearing their name is awarded to talented students pursuing music curriculum as undergraduates or graduate students at higher institutions of learning.

The Clyde & Marian Connelly Music Scholarship is available to former graduates of Branch, Barry, Calhoun, Eaton, Ingham, Jackson, and Kalamazoo Counties who are in their third through fifth year of **college**. Applicants must show continued education in music, with a preference given to those with a Music related major or minor. Previous recipients are eligible to reapply, but no more than three annual awards per person. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required.

Essay Questions: Please provide a one-page type written response to the following questions on a separate page, recording your name in the upper right hand corner.

- What has drawn you to the field of music?
- What do you hope to accomplish?

Recommendation Letter: Please provide one recommendation letter from a Music Teacher with whom you have studied.

Financial Criteria: Yes, complete the financial information portion of the online application and upload the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report.
