**Description/ Qualifying Criteria:** Scholarships awarded annually to Marshall High School graduating seniors or graduating seniors who are residents of Marshall, MI. Applicants must plan to attend a two- or four-year undergraduate college as a full time student. Financial need, involvement in community service activities, co- and extra-curricular activities and GPA may all be determining factors.

**Rotary Mission Statement:** The mission of Rotary International is to provide service to others, promote integrity, and advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through its fellowship of business, professional, and community leaders.

**Essay Questions:** Write a personal statement including how you are living in a way that reflects the mission of Rotary International.

**Recommendation Letters:** Two required- one from a school educator, administrator or someone associated with the school such as, but not limited to, a coach, and the other from a Marshall Rotary Club member who is not a family member.

**Financial Criteria:** *Yes, complete the financial information portion of the online application and upload the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report.*
