

### **K. John Lord Engineering and Science Scholarship**

**Description/ Qualifying Criteria:** Scholarships awarded to Marshall High School graduating seniors or previous MHS graduates pursuing a career in the field of engineering or the sciences. Applicants must attend a two- or four-year institution as a full-time student. Preference may be given to applicants demonstrating financial need, but GPA is not a determining factor. Students who receive this scholarship are encouraged to apply for further support in subsequent years.

**Essay Questions:** Why are you pursuing a career in engineering and/or science and what do you hope to achieve by obtaining a degree in your chosen field?

**Recommendation Letters:** Two required- one from a **recent** school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

**Financial Criteria:** *Yes, complete the financial information portion of the online application and upload the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report.*
