Description/ Qualifying Criteria: Scholarships awarded to Calhoun County residents seeking to further their education in natural resources or a related field at any Michigan college or university. Applicants may enroll at a two-year institution with plans to complete at a four-year institution. A minimum of 2.5 GPA is required. Students who receive this scholarship are encouraged to apply for further support in subsequent years however, applicants must submit updated supporting materials. Previously submitted narratives or letters of recommendation will not be accepted.

Essay Questions: 1) Why have you chosen the natural resources field? 2) Describe your experience or community service pertaining to natural resources (Agriculture experience, classes, FFA, 4-H, etc.)

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a <u>recent</u> school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: Not required
