

Benjamin W. Dorr Memorial Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *A scholarship awarded to a Marshall High School graduating senior with a demonstrated record of service to others and a desire to work in a field that includes community service as a major component. Priority will be given to applicants pursuing a degree that entails service to others, such as but not limited to, teaching, social work, nonprofit management, community building, or caregiving for those with special needs. Preference will be given to those attending an in state school. Scholarship applicants should demonstrate financial need and a minimum 2.5 GPA. Students who receive this scholarship are encouraged to apply for further support in subsequent years; however, scholarship may be awarded for no more than two years to one recipient.*

Essay Questions: *Please respond to the essay question in a meaningful, but concise essay of 200 words or less. What are your career goals and how do you intend to achieve them?*

Recommendation Letters: One required from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, complete the financial information portion of the online application and upload the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report.*
