Description/ Qualifying Criteria: Scholarships awarded to students who have received Jesus Christ as his/her Savior and are in good standing as a member of a local Christian church. Applicants must be pursuing a career as a Minister of the Gospel of Jesus Christ or other full-time ministry and show proof of enrollment to a Christian college, such as but not limited to, Cornerstone University, Springfield Bible Baptist College, Moody Bible Institute, Northland Baptist College, Pensacola Christian College or additional Christian colleges approved by the committee. Preference may be given to applicants with associations to Calhoun County, Mich. and the surrounding area. Financial information is requested, but not necessarily a determining factor. Students who receive this scholarship are encouraged to apply for further support in subsequent years however, applicants must submit updated supporting materials. Previously submitted narratives or letters of recommendation will not be accepted.

**Essay Questions**: 1) When did you become a Christian and how did that take place? 2) Why have you chosen to pursue an education in Christian Ministry?

**Essay Question for Previous Recipients**: 1) How have your most recent classes or experiences influenced your faith and your desire to pursue an education in Christian Ministry?

**Recommendation Letters**: Two required- one from your pastor and one from a mentor (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: Yes, complete the financial information portion of the online application and upload your FAFSA Student Aid Index Report.
