Transcripts and scores are requested, but not necessarily a determining factor. Previously submitted narratives or letters of recommendation will not be accepted.

Essay Questions: Why are you pursuing a career in engineering and/or science and what do you hope to achieve by obtaining a degree in your chosen field?

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a <u>recent</u> school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: Yes, complete the financial information portion of the online application and upload your FAFSA Student Aid Index Report.
