

Marilyn Paskett Memorial Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *A scholarship awarded to a Marshall High School graduating senior or previous MHS graduates pursuing a degree in the teaching profession (elementary or secondary) while attending any four-year institution on a part- or full-time basis. Applicants must provide a list of community and school activities and a job history. Financial information is requested, but not necessarily a determining factor. A minimum 2.0 GPA is required. Students who receive this scholarship are encouraged to apply for further support in subsequent years.*

Essay Questions: 1) Why have you chosen the teaching profession as your goal? 2) Why do you feel it is important to be involved in extra curricular activities and how have they impacted your life?

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a school educator/administrator and one from an employer or an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, complete the financial information portion of the online application and upload the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report.*

Application Process: Complete the online application found on the Marshall Community Foundation website: marshallcf.org/receive/scholarships/apply/. This is a new process, so please contact the Foundation for assistance or with any questions you may have.
