Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *Scholarship awarded to a Marshall High School graduating senior who has demonstrated initiative and a strong work ethic. Applicants must provide proof of part-time employment of 15 hours/week during high school. GPA is not a determining factor.*

Essay Questions: 1) Describe yourself; the person you are today and the person you hope to become. 2) Describe the importance of your current part-time job and how it has impacted you with present and future goals.

Recommendation Letters: One required from an employer.

Financial Criteria: Not required
