Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *Scholarships awarded to Marshall area graduating seniors or Marshall area residents 20 years of age or younger who have earned their GED. Applicants must be pursuing a two- or four- year degree or advanced education and/or training in the skilled trades and show evidence of involvement in co or extra-curricular activities or volunteerism related to the applicant's field of interest. Transcripts and scores are requested, but not necessarily a determining factor.*

Essay Questions: 1) Write a "Recommendation Letter" for yourself. 2) What do you think you will be doing ten years after your high school graduation?

Financial Criteria: Not required
