Peter C. Stuart Journalism Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: Scholarship awarded to graduating seniors residing in Calhoun County or graduating from a school within the CISD pursuing a career in journalism or a clearly related curriculum at a four-year institution. Financial need is not required but may be a determining factor. Students who receive this scholarship are encouraged to apply for further support in subsequent years however, applicants must submit updated supporting materials. Previously submitted narratives or letters of recommendation will not be accepted.

Essay Question: Prepare a short essay on the impact of electronic media upon the written media and how the principle of truthful and accurate reporting can be maintained. (The significant change in publication of the Monitor from all print to a combination of print and electronic media is a good example of the change which has taken place.)

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a <u>recent</u> school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: Yes, complete the financial information portion of the online application and upload your FAFSA Student Aid Index Report.
