

Peter C. Stuart Journalism Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *A scholarship awarded to a Marshall High School graduating senior or previous MHS graduate pursuing a career in journalism or a clearly related curriculum at a four-year institution. Financial need is not required but may be a determining factor. Students who receive this scholarship may apply for further support in subsequent years.*

Essay Question: Prepare a short essay on the impact of the electronic media upon the written media and how the principle of truthful and accurate reporting can be maintained. (The significant change in publication of the Monitor from all print to a combination of print and electronic media is a good example of the change which has taken place.)

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a recent school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, complete the financial information portion of the online application and upload the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report.*
