Wagner-Kaiser STEM Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: Scholarships awarded to graduating seniors residing in Calhoun County or graduates from a school within the CISD pursuing a degree in a STEM related field. Applicants must identify as female or be a member of an underrepresented group and demonstrate financial need. Preference may be given to those pursuing a degree in physics, astronomy, or statistics. Advanced coursework or volunteerism/participation in relevant STEMrelated activities and GPA may be a determining factor. Previous graduates must submit proof of graduation from a school within the CISD. Students who receive this scholarship may apply for further support in subsequent years, however, applicants must submit updated supporting materials. Previously submitted narratives or letters of recommendation will not be accepted.

Essay Question: Provide a personal narrative on how your experiences or volunteer work relate to your plans to study a STEM-related field in college.

Recommendation Letters: Not required.

Financial Criteria: Yes, complete the financial information portion of the online application and upload the <u>first page only</u> of your FAFSA Student Aid Report.
