

## **Beatrice Williams Scholarship**

**Description/ Qualifying Criteria:** Scholarships awarded to Marshall area graduating seniors or previous graduates from the Marshall area pursuing a degree in the field of education. Preference may be given to those pursuing a degree in Elementary or early childhood development. Students who receive this scholarship are encouraged to apply for further support in subsequent years. Transcripts and scores are requested, but not necessarily a determining factor.

**Essay Questions:** 1) Why have you chosen a career in the field of education as your goal? Include information regarding your experience working with youth. Childcare, playground supervision and assisting in a classroom as a volunteer are experiences to draw upon.

**Recommendation Letters:** Two required- one from a school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

**Financial Criteria:** Not required
