

Herold and Retta Reuss Public Safety Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: Scholarships awarded to Marshall-area residents pursuing a career in the criminal justice, first responder services, or other public safety related fields, such as but not limited to, fireman, policeman, legal secretary or dispatcher. Applicants must demonstrate the drive and ability to be successful in pursuing a college education and/or a certification process in the fields aforementioned. Financial information is requested, but not necessarily a determining factor. Students who receive this scholarship may apply for further support in subsequent years.

Essay Questions: What Public Safety field have you chosen to pursue in your studies? What made you decide to pursue this career? How do you hope to impact the community around you?

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a **recent** school educator/administrator or employer and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, complete the financial information portion of the online application and upload the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report.*
