Description/ Qualifying Criteria: Scholarships awarded to Marshall High School graduating seniors in pursuit of a college education. Jeff was known for his great smile but he was also known to be an active, vibrant, kind-hearted individual. Although this is just a brief overview of who Jeff was, it describes not only his outgoing personality and love of life but how much he cared about others. Applicants should exemplify Jeff's personal attributes of kindness, respect, consideration, and humility with the courage to be a positive influence for Marshall Youth. GPA is not a determining factor.

Essay Questions: 1) As demonstrated above, Jeff Seybert exemplified many great qualities as a student at MHS. In comparing yourself to Jeff, select one of his personal characteristics that describe you best and explain why. Be sure to give specific examples from your life. 2) Attach a brief autobiography.

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).
