

Beatrice Williams Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: Scholarships awarded to Marshall graduating seniors pursuing a degree in the field of education at a two- or four-year institution as a full-time student. Preference may be given to those pursuing a degree in Elementary or early childhood development. GPA is not a determining factor.

Essay Questions: 1) Why have you chosen a career in the field of education as your goal? Include information regarding your experience working with youth. Childcare, playground supervision and assisting in a classroom as a volunteer are experiences to draw upon.

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: Not required
